GENESIS 1-12

As its opening words suggest, the book of Genesis is first of all a book about God. At the same time, it is a book that reveals his grand design for humanity. The early chapters help us make sense of ourselves, our purpose, value and identity as creatures made in the image of our relational Creator. They give us a handle on why the world is as we encounter it, beautiful yet broken, and most importantly, we discover the pattern and promise of redemption and renewal that is accomplished in and through Christ Jesus. Here is our hope, here is our place in his story.
