THE NICENE CREED

The Nicene Creed has been lauded as one of the most important statements of Christian belief in the history of the Church. Recited by believers since the Second Ecumenical Council of 381, it is cherished for its precision and beauty. We explore the doctrines of scripture summarised in the creed to further our understanding of 'the faith once for all delivered to the saints,' to become more confident in articulating what we believe, and to grow in our devotion to the one God who is the Father of the Son in the joy of the Holy Spirit, the God who acts for us and for our salvation, the God who is good news.

Accompanying our consideration of the Nicene Creed, this series will provide an opportunity to explore the nature of God, to discover how the Trinity makes sense of our world, and to reflect on the comfort, hope and purpose the Triune God brings to our lives. 11th, 18th, 25th September; 9th, 16th, 23rd October.

321: GOD, WORLD, YOU

A fresh look at how Jesus makes sense of everything and offers hope for the world. Our Sunday morning groups serve children aged 3-14 years. This term, our children will be following a similar programme to the adults, considering the content of the Nicene Creed. Throughout the Advent season we count down to Christmas by engaging with the characters of the nativity.
