### Hello and Happy New Year!

January is already flying by and we're all in full swing for the year ahead, but I am still reflecting on what a great 2025 we had at CAP Wirral.

We saw 15 families go debt free, we were able to grant lots of emergency aid through food shops with the money we were given through the council's Household Support Fund, we partnered with Woodchurch High School to deliver CAP's Money Coaching for Youth to most of Year 9 pupils and we continued successful partnerships with local organisations through our drop ins. We are increasingly more visible in the community, and people are hearing about CAP and the positive impact the local church is having in the community through our debt help work.

We want to say thank you to you all for our continued support for the work God has given us to do. Thanks for your prayers for us, for our clients, and for the impact that the Gospel of Jesus has on their lives. We believe that God is in all of our interactions with the families we work with and He is changing lives. He is their Father and He loves them, just as He loves us all.

I was reflecting this morning on His fatherhood. Jesus called him 'Abba'. A term of personal intimacy with His Father. We also can have this intimacy, and so can those we work with.
