I hope you are enjoying this exceptionally warm British summer. The flowers are blooming, but aren't they hard to keep on top of, with all the pruning that's needed?! I find it a challenge. But it needs to be done in order for them to reflower and rebirth. That's how God works with us. I want to tell you about a new client. I'll call her C.

C had trauma from a difficult past and suffers with deep anxiety. She has been worried for her son, who due to his own trauma has been sectioned. When we first met C, she cried throughout the whole session. On our second visit, we didn't get to the debts straight away as there are sometimes so many layers to have to peel back in a client's life. We spent the first hour of that session talking about Jesus and how He wants to heal her heart, show her He is the way, the truth and the life, and that He gave His life for her. She accepted Jesus through a prayer that our befriender Beth led her in. The next appointment, she was dressed, well put together and stronger. Although there was still some anxiety, God works with us step by step, chipping away at what needs to go, pruning what needs to be cut back, and building what needs to be built.

We are God's masterpiece. C is God's masterpiece. We get to be part of her journey to freedom, financially and spiritually! Praise be to God. And thank you for your prayers, your giving and belief in our work.
