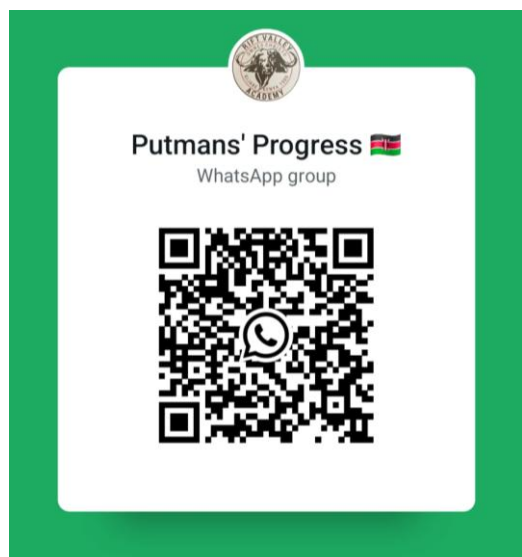
We can drive into Nairobi or Naivasha for days out to get supplies or go walking in the beautiful hills around Kijabe.
